P/18/1030 Public Questions and Comments – (3 Minutes per speaker a maximum 15 Minutes in total) Three members of the public stated that they wished to object to Planning Application 18/00871/FUL; they stated that the proposed application was not in-keeping with the rest of the street scene and is an overdevelopment of the site. They feel it will cause issues with the sewers, which have on a number of occasions been blocked and over-flowed in to gardens and properties on the street. The proposed double garage is not in-keeping with existing properties and will affect visibility on to a busy junction of a road which is heavily congested during school drop off and pick up times. Concerns were also raised as the 'trees' estate is 'openplan', and this would detract from that.

Cllr Bull advised that the Town Council were consultee's, and advised that objections be made formally to DDDC, and a request that the application be taken to committee.
