



Ashbourne Town Council – Councillor Vacancy Hilltop Ward

If you are enthusiastic and passionate about our town, Ashbourne Town Council has a vacancy for a Councillor in the Hilltop Ward.

The Town Council is part of local government closest to the people, the role of Councillor is to represent their parishioners on relevant matters. You will also be required to assist with Town Council community events throughout the year.

To be eligible for the position you must be:

- A British subject, or a citizen of the Commonwealth or the European Union
- 18 years or over
- Be a local government elector for the council area; or
- Have during the whole of the 12 months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or premises in the council area; or
- Have during that same period had your principal or only place of work in the council area
- During that 12-month period resided in the council area (In the case of a sitting member of a parish council you can satisfy the criteria to be elected if you have lived in the council area or within 3 miles or it for the whole of the 12 months preceding)

The Town Council usually meet on the 3rd Tuesday of the month and in addition to this there are three committees which also meet monthly.
